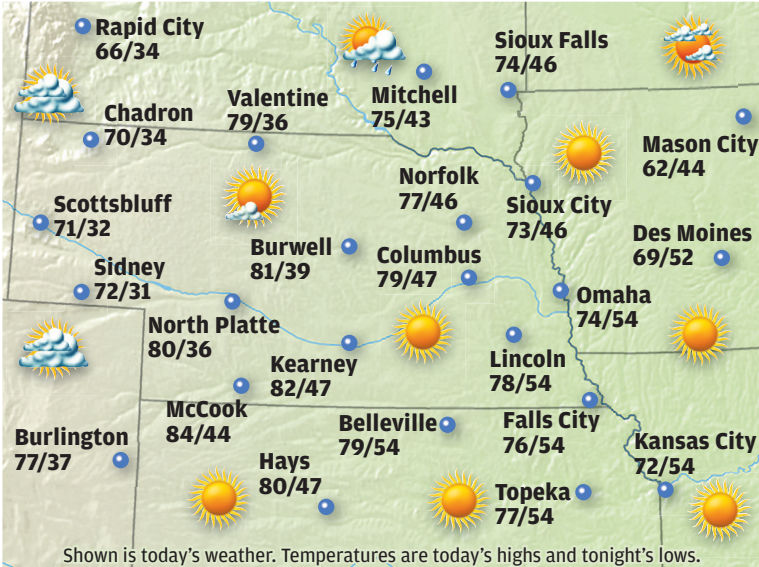

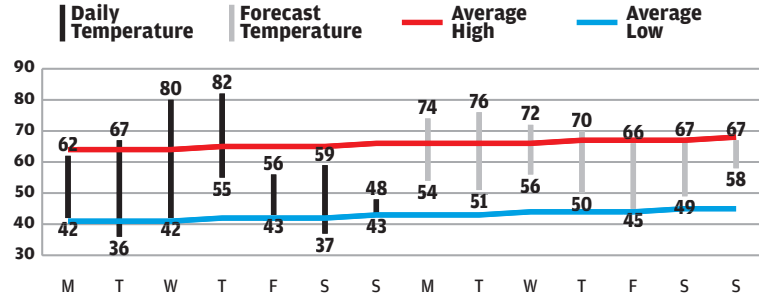

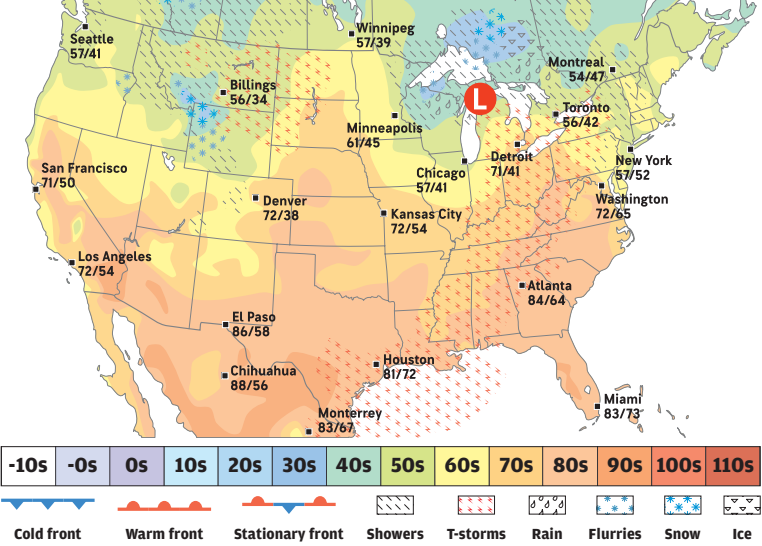

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National Outlook: Thunderstorms stretching from the Gulf Coast up into the Ohio River Valley and western New York can produce drenching rain, small hail and locally damaging wind gusts today. The Southeast is expected to remain warm and dry along the Atlantic coast, while the Great Lakes should be breezy. The Great Plains are anticipated to turn warmer as well.
