

As you know, the Unicameral voted to repeal the Death Penalty over my objections and my veto. The Legislature's actions served to soften our state's approach to dealing with Nebraska's most hardened and heinous criminals, and make it more difficult for Nebraska law enforcement to prosecute the worst criminals – putting Nebraska families and public safety at risk.

As Governor, I am determined to protect our citizens and committed to supporting law enforcement in our communities, across the state and in our correctional facilities.

That is why I am supporting the referendum petition effort of Nebraskans for the Death Penalty. Their mission is clear - to gather enough signatures to overturn Ernie Chambers' bill to repeal the death penalty in Nebraska.

State Senators who voted to repeal the death penalty have ignored the 64 percent majority of Nebraskans who overwhelming support the death penalty. And now, the media is reporting that liberal financier George Soros provides funding to an outside group that has given \$400,000 to the ACLU to oppose the referendum effort.
